

Wholetime Firefighter Vacancies – West Devon Area

Devon and Somerset Fire and Rescue Service currently have 5 Wholetime Firefighter vacancies within the City of Plymouth. Applications are invited from Wholetime personnel from other Local Authority Fire Services who may wish to transfer into these positions.

Applicants must be at competent level within the Firefighter role map and be willing to develop their skills within specialist roles with a view to career progression within our organisation. Applications will also be accepted from higher current role levels if the individual is prepared to accept a Firefighter role and work through the ADC system again to attain a higher level. Successful applicants will be expected to serve at least two years within the West Devon Area unless they gain promotion.

Assessments will take place on either the 11th or 12th June at our Training Centre based in Plympton, Plymouth. Details of the assessments will be sent to those shortlisted but it should be noted that the assessments will include a bleep test up to level 8.4.
