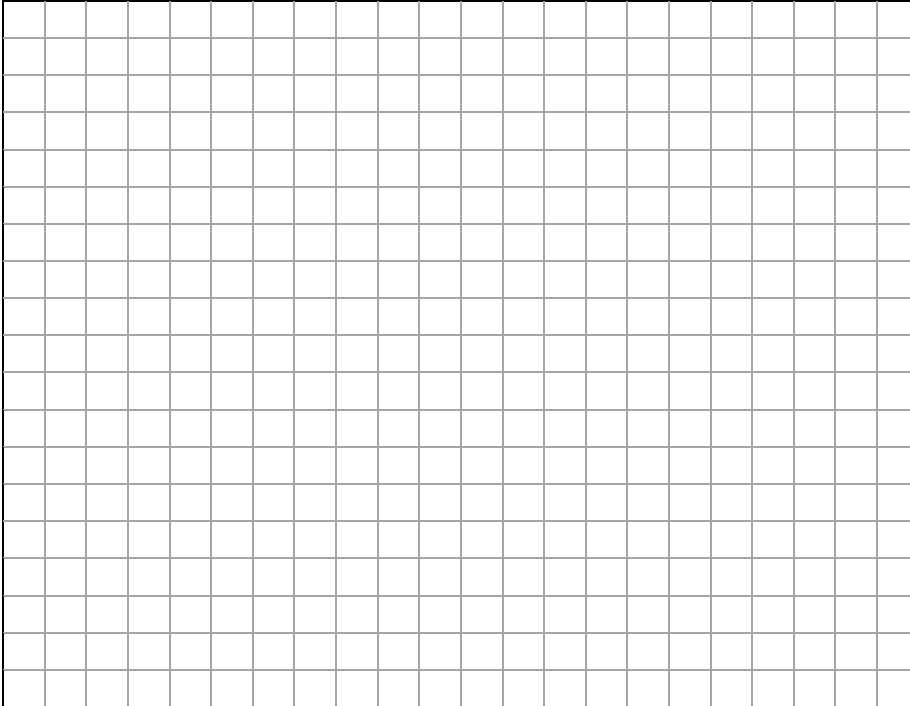


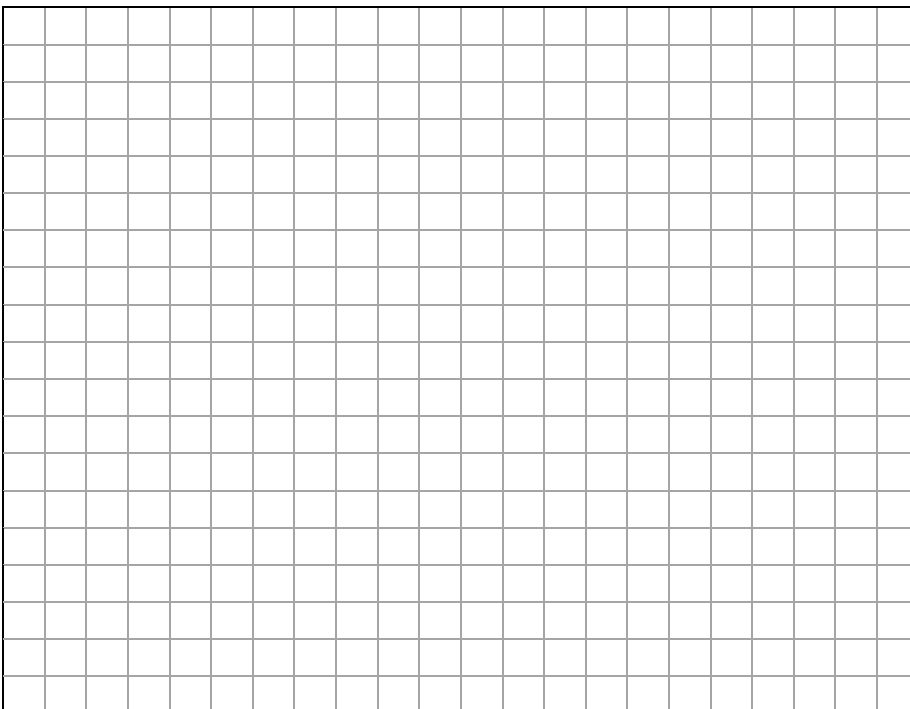


1. Draw a floor plan on the grids below for each floor of your home.

These are some of the questions the Fire Service have to answer when we talk to people about Fire Escape Plans and how to keep safe at home. Can you answer them for us? There are answers at the bottom you can choose from

1. Why must you block the gaps around the door if you are trapped in a room?
2. How will you call 999 if you no-one has a phone?
3. What must you do if you have to get through a smoky room or corridor?
4. Which upstairs room is best to gather in if you are trapped and cannot get downstairs?
5. What should you do if your smoke alarm goes off?
6. What must you never do once you are out of the house?
7. If a fire should start, what can you do beforehand to stop smoke and fire spreading?
8. What should you do with all keys to outside doors and windows?
9. How do you know if everyone is out of the house and safe?
10. Should someone go to find the fire and try to put it out?

Get out, stay out and call 999!	Never try to find out where the fire has started. Never try to tackle a fire. Get out safely and quickly	
Close all doors before you go to bed or before you go out for the day.	Knock on your neighbours' doors. Shout fire! As loudly as you can	A room at the front of the house A room with a window.
Stay low to the ground as the air is clearer. Smoke goes up.	Don't go back inside – not for anything!	To stop smoke getting into the room
Make sure everyone meets at the place you have decided on in your fire escape plan. Tell the fire service if not everyone is there.	Keep them somewhere near the door where everyone can find them.
